Susan B. Anthony to Lecture in This Place.

She will talk in Morgan Hall, April 19th, on Question of Suffrage for Women and will organize a Political Equality Club at this time.

After considerable persuasion, Susan B. Anthony has consented to come here and lecture, before starting the last of this month on her trip to California.

Miss Anthony is the most celebrated woman speaker of the age and justly so. She is the President of the National American Woman Suffrage Association, and has devoted the best part of her life toward that cause.
